

DID YOU KNOW ...

The property owner is responsible for the maintenance of the sidewalk abutting their property?

If you have a sidewalk abutting your property, it is the property owner's responsibility to make sure the sidewalk is kept clear of all obstructions and to make sure it is safe for pedestrians. (WMC 12.08.020)

From time to time, the Public Works Director will inspect the sidewalks and curbs within the City limits to determine whether repairs and/or replacement is needed. (WMC 12.08.010)

If your sidewalk or curb needs to be repaired or replaced, make sure you apply for a Right-of-Way Permit before work is started. You can apply for a Right-of-Way Permit on the City of Woodland website or stop by our Public Works office at 236 Suite B Davidson Ave Woodland, WA 98674.
