Meeting Description

The City and community of Woodland is identifying climate resilience policies to integrate into the City's Comprehensive Plan in partnership with the Washington State Department of Commerce as part of a Climate Pilot Program. The climate resiliency analysis of the Woodland Comprehensive Plan will build on current and prior work such as the 2016-2036 Woodland Comprehensive Plan, 2021 Shoreline Master Program, and the 2019 Cowlitz County Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan, and other efforts. The planning process will additionally identify new opportunities for ambitious, feasible, and equitable climate action that builds readiness for climate impacts such as extreme heat and increased flooding.

Public engagement through the Planning Commission is essential to this process. During this Planning Commission meeting, the project team will introduce the Climate Resilience Comprehensive Plan Integration Project and provide an overview of climate impacts and climate vulnerability relevant to the

City of Woodland. Meeting participants will have the opportunity to review and discuss draft resilience policies for consideration with the Comprehensive Plan.

Background on Washington State Department of Commerce Climate Pilot Program: The purpose of the pilot program is to provide guidance and tools to assist local governments in integrating climate change into their comprehensive plans. Commerce has chosen three communities, one of which being Woodland, to offer direct assistance to use a flexible framework for cities and counties to integrate climate goals and policies into their comprehensive plan voluntarily. This pilot will help Commerce and others improve and optimize climate resilience guidance and tools to ensure their usefulness and effectiveness.
