PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

Schedule A: Construction of a new, approximately 12-foot by 10-foot office addition to the City's existing WWTP office/lab building, including electrical and mechanical improvements.

Schedule B: Construction of a new, approximately 28-foot by 28-foot shop building, including adjacent surface restoration, located adjacent to the WWTP office/lab building.

Schedule C: Construction of a two-bay addition to the City's Public Works Shop.

State Sales Taxes -- the provisions of Section 1-07.2(2) - Rule 170 – apply to this project. The Contractor shall include Washington State Retail Sales Taxes on the full contract price.

All construction and material, unless otherwise specified, shall be in accordance with the most current Standard Specifications and Standard Plans for Road, Bridge and Municipal Construction as prepared by the Washington State Department of Transportation and as amended under Amendments to the Standard Specifications, and the American Public Works Association, and the City of Woodland Engineering Standards for Construction and all other codes as required by the Contract Documents.
