

INVITATION TO BID
CITY OF WOODLAND WTP STATIC MIXER AND PIPE REPLACEMENT

The following project will be accomplished as a **SMALL WORKS PROJECT** and will be subject to prevailing wage laws.

Proposals for furnishing all materials, labor and equipment for the following described work will be received by the City of Woodland Public Works Office at 236-B Davidson Avenue, Woodland, WA 98674 or by electronic mail at myklebustk@ci.woodland.wa.us. Bids will be accepted until 11:00 AM on February 6, 2024.

A pre-bid walkthrough (non-mandatory) is scheduled for January 30, 2024 at 9 a.m. at the Water Treatment Plant, located at 130 Scott Hill Road, Woodland, WA 98674.

PROJECT NAME: WTP STATIC MIXER AND PIPE REPLACEMENT PROJECT

PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

Removal and replacement of an existing static mixer and associated water piping and appurtenances at the City of Woodland Water Treatment Plant.

ORDER OF WORK:

1. City to deliver pre-purchased static mixer to Contractor at the WTP.
2. Contractor to weld three (3) new stainless steel threadlets into new water piping.
3. Contractor to fabricate new 316L stainless steel water pipe and welded slip on flanges.
4. Contractor to fabricate 316L stainless steel pipe with mechanical joint flanges.
5. Prior to day of installation: Contractor to mobilize welding / lifting equipment to WTP.
6. Day of installation: City will shut down flow through existing static mixer and associated water piping and drain water from piping.
7. Contractor must be prepared to install a temporary piping system if the work cannot be completed within one (1) twelve-hour working day. Temporary piping system must be capable of supplying raw water to the WTP at a flow rate of 625 gallons per minute (gpm).
8. Contractor to remove existing ductile iron water piping, fittings, and appurtenances in static mixer pit, approximately 16 feet.
9. Contractor to prepare surface of existing pipe stubs for connection to new 316L stainless steel water pipe.
10. Contractor to prepare existing pipe connections for application of protective coating.
11. Contractor to set new static mixer on existing pedestal.
12. Contractor to connect new 316L stainless steel water piping to existing.
13. Contractor to run water at full flow to ensure integrity of welds.
14. Contractor to clean up and de-mobilize from jobsite.

Note: Contractor must be certified to enter confined spaces and is responsible for providing all appropriate PPE to safely complete the work and comply with all applicable regulations. All new parts and accessories must meet NSF 61 and AWWA requirements for contact with potable water.

All proposals must be submitted on the Bid Proposal Form included in the bid documents. Work shall be completed within one (1) twelve-hour working day (coordinated with the City) and shall begin no later than thirty (30) calendar days of the date that Notice to Proceed is issued to the Contractor. Exceeding this timeframe shall incur liquidated damages at a rate of \$1000 per day.

State Sales Taxes -- the provisions of Section 1-07.2(2) - Rule 170 – apply to this project. The Contractor shall include Washington State Retail Sales Taxes on the full contract price.

All construction and material, unless otherwise specified, shall be in accordance with the most current Standard Specifications and Standard Plans for Road, Bridge and Municipal Construction as prepared by the Washington State Department of Transportation and as amended under Amendments to the Standard Specifications, and the American Public Works Association, and the City of Woodland Engineering Standards for Construction and all other codes as required by the Contract Documents.

The City of Woodland reserves the right to cancel this request or reject any and all bids received or to waive any minor formalities of this invitation to bid if in the judgment of the City Council the best interests of the City would be served.

The undersigned, as bidder, declares that we will contract with the City of Woodland to do everything necessary to complete the WTP Static Mixer and Pipe Replacement project, as presented.

If our BID is accepted, we agree to sign a Certification of Compliance with Wage Payment Statutes, provide Employment Security Department account standing, to sign an Affidavit of Compliance for E-Verify, Performance Bond, Payment Bond, to obtain a City of Woodland Business License, and to provide the required evidence of insurance within fifteen (15) working days after receiving written notice of the contract award.

Each bid must be accompanied by a certified check or bidder's bond in an amount not less than five percent (5%) of the total bid. Should the successful bidder fail to enter into contract and furnish satisfactory payment and performance bond within the time stated above, the bid proposal deposit shall be forfeited.

We further agree, if our BID is accepted to so plan the work and to prosecute it with such diligence that all of the work shall be completed within the period stated. We understand that the City of Woodland reserves the right to reject any bid and accept the bid in the best interests of the City of Woodland and that the City of Woodland also reserves the right to waive any informalities in any proposal or bid.

We further state that we have not, either directly or indirectly, entered into any agreement, participated in any collusion, or otherwise taken any action in restraint of free competitive bidding regarding such contract.

Work shall be completed within one (1) twelve-hour working day (coordinated with the City) and shall begin no later than thirty (30) calendar days of the date that Notice to Proceed is issued to the Contractor. Exceeding this timeframe shall incur liquidated damages at a rate of \$1000 per day.
